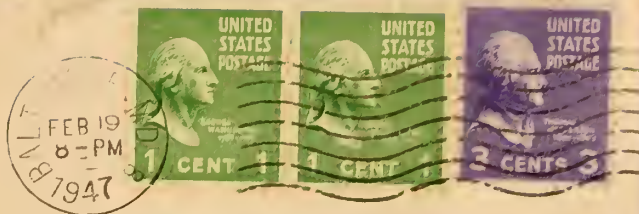

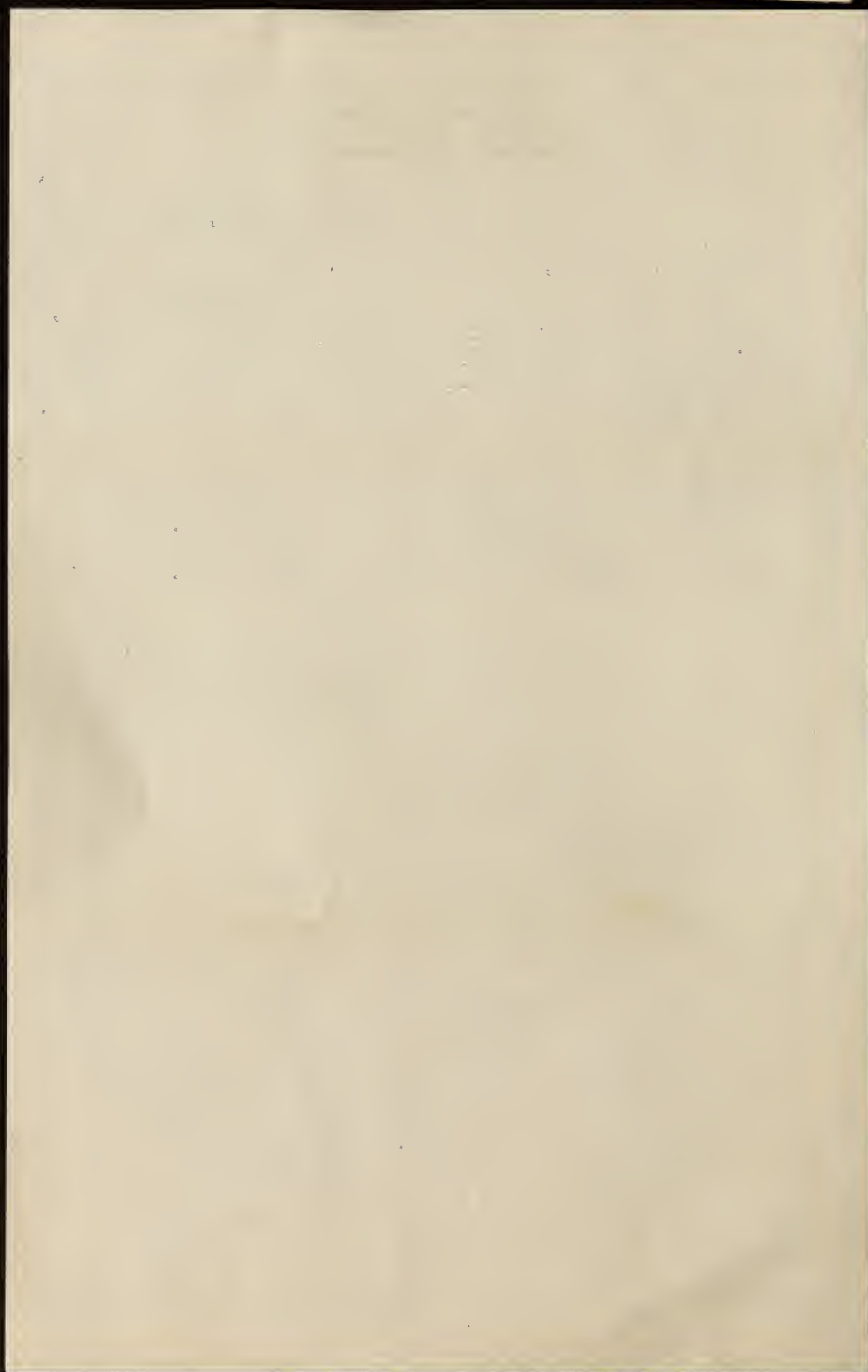
Dear Dr. Schneid,
